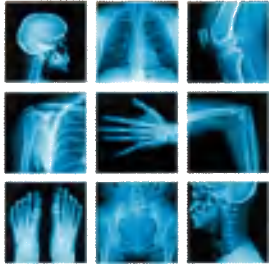

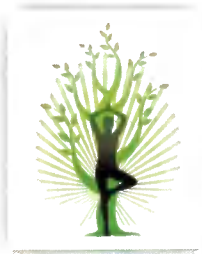

South Zone Home Care

Home Care is publicly funded personal and healthcare services for clients of all ages living in a private residence or other setting, such as suites in a retirement residence. Anyone living in Alberta with a valid healthcare card can receive Home Care services, as long as their needs can be met safely in their place of residence. Home Care does not provide all services a client may need, but can help arrange other supports provided in your community.

Personal Care Services

Home Care Managers
